October 1, 2019-January 8, 2020

(applications submitted after 1/8/20 will **not** be eligible for Fulcrum grants)

You can access the application from the St. Luke website (under the Admissions tab, then Tuition Assistance) or by using the link https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FW06

As a reminder, submitting the application online is just the first step. All applicants must also provide supporting documentation, like tax forms and W-2's. Applications can only be verified and processed once all necessary documentation is submitted. It takes FACTS about 14 business days to process applications once paperwork is received, so the sooner it's submitted, the better.


